Dr. Farzeen Nasri is Professor of Political Economy at the University of California at Santa Barbara and Ventura College. He chairs the Committee on International Education, as well as the Subcommittee on Curriculum Development, Nuclear Age Peace Foundation. He is Professor of International Law at Southern California Institute of Law. Dr. Nasri taught international politics and economic studies at Golden Gate University and Westmont College. He has served on the Board of the United Nations Association and has been a member of the Organizing Committee Symposium on "Iran in the 1990s". He was a founding member of the National Council of Citizens. Dr. Nasri authored *European Community and the Third World* (IIPES, 1979) in addition to numerous articles and book reviews. Dr. Nasri has a B.B.A. in Management from Tehran School of Management, graduate degrees in International Economics from Tehran University, and International Relations from New York University. He earned a Ph.D. in Political Science from the Graduate Faculty, New School for Social Research, New York.
