Mark Rose is Distinguished Research Professor Emeritus at UC Santa Barbara. He is the author of Shakespearean Design (Harvard UP, 1972) as well as many books on other subjects including Elizabethan poetry, science fiction, and the history of copyright. His most recent book is Authors in Court: Scenes from the Theater of Copyright (Harvard UP, 2016). In addition to continuing to teach Shakespeare at UCSB he often serves as an expert witness in Hollywood-related copyright matters.
