## ***A Sense of Wonder: Honoring Rachel Carson***

The heroic personal and professional struggle of Rachel Carson, a pioneer of the contemporary environmental movement, is depicted in a documentary drama. Carson scientifically demonstrated the interdependence of all life and the harmful effects of human tools of environmental control such as the use of chemical pesticides. Her writings, including the bestseller, *Silent Spring*, and fearless lectures provoked an intense policy debate that continues to the present day.

A short talk by Sandhya Tillotson will introduce the program at Concord House, 1407 Chapala Street, Santa Barbara, home of the Institute of World Culture which is celebrating the 34th anniversary of its founding.
